

The Social's Program Committee organise the evening's program (i.e. the time in which you appear on stage) from the list of names provided to them by the MC. If you arrive after 6pm please immediately report to the MC. The Social's Program Committee will do their best to slot you into the program, but with limited time available it is not always possible to accommodate everyone.

Please refer to the white board (left of the stage) which will display the order in which walk-up artists appear.

Each artist may perform two songs, with no encores, three songs for duets, or a total of 15 minutes for bands. Please advise the Stage Hands if you require backing. Chord charts for backing musicians are always helpful and preferable.

There is a room behind stage for your preparation. You must be ready and waiting back stage at least 10 minutes before your performance. Please ensure instruments are tuned **before** going on stage.



Regular artists over the years have included Kasey Chambers, Troy Cassar-Daley, Lee Kernaghan and Gina Jeffreys. Our own club members Kiara Rodrigues, Kevin and Dehlia have also been among the talented artists who have been seen playing there. The official website www.tamworthcountrymusic.com.au is packed with information on accommodation, venues, ticket pricing and bookings.

SUBMITTING AN ARTICLE FOR THE NEWSLETTER

1. The newsletter uses the Font – Calibri size 14. By using this font and narrow margins when you write your articles it will help you to determine how long your piece is.
2. Photos need to be sent in colour as the newsletter is also added to our website.
3. Photos which are too dark are difficult to lighten for B&W printing and sometimes cannot be used.
4. Except for reducing the resolution, for emailing, please don't crop your photos as it affects any template sizes.
5. Posters are best sent as a word document so that any changes can be made.
6. If you are not sure how to put your article together let me know as I am happy to assist you.
7. Due to space sometimes your article will need to be carried over to another addition or edited to allow it to fit. Our aim is to avoid this but unfortunately this cannot always be the case.
8. Remember that we have a website and Facebook page that we can include your photos on.
9. Unfortunately anything received after the deadline will not be able to be included unless previous arrangements have been made.
10. But most importantly we are interested in what is happening with our members and guest so keep submitting those articles for everyone to enjoy.


